AS GOOD AS IT GETS

It's the time of year when Jewish music takes center stage. Shabbat Shirah (January 14,15) kicks it off, inviting our spirits to soar on wings of song throughout the weeks to come. While it is the official beginning of Jewish Music Month, for me it always heralds a time of great immersion in ALL music. Although the conventional wisdom may be that music can only be properly appreciated by those who are "musical", in truth,

music is both a universal language and an equal opportunity form of expression. It is a gift, generously given to us by The Creator, equal in its potency and beauty to the gifts of love and compassion, for it too can heal, uplift and transform.

Going back to the ancient days of Shabbat Shirah itself we find the Song of the Sea healing a depressed, enslaved people as they cross The Reed's Sea transformed into peoplehood. MI CHAMOCHA BA'ELIM ADONAI, they sang, WHO IS LIKE UNTO YOU, OH GOD?!

Our most revered king, King David, stepped onto history's stage as a harp-playing young shepherd, whose music gave him entree into King Saul's palace. The king's melancholia needed this gentle instrument's music played expertly by its young virtuoso to heal his wounded spirit.

During the days of the Great Temple in Jerusalem, the Levites (the members of the tribe of Levi) who were the Singers of Prayers, received their support and sustenance from the citizenry of the land, so as to allow them to fully concentrate on the preparations and performances of their sacred musical tasks for the temple services untarnished by the distractions of daily life.

Every era is often definable by its music in ways more meaningful than mere words. Who can forget the indelible Holocaust descriptions of our own brothers and sisters

Lunch & Learn: Jewish Mysticism Study

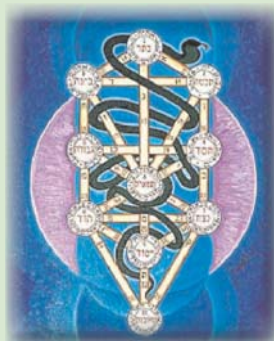

It is not just a spiritual value. Science verifies that it is good to get out in nature. Some scientists argue that heavy technology use [cell phones, emails, texting] can inhibit deep thought and cause anxiety, and that getting out into nature can help. A University of Michigan study showed that people can better learn after walking in the woods than after walking a busy street because learning centers in the brain become taxed when asked to process information, even during the relatively passive experience of taking in an urban setting.

Nature can refresh the brain. In nature, our senses recalibrate — you notice sounds, smells, sights... you become more connected to the physical environment, the earth.

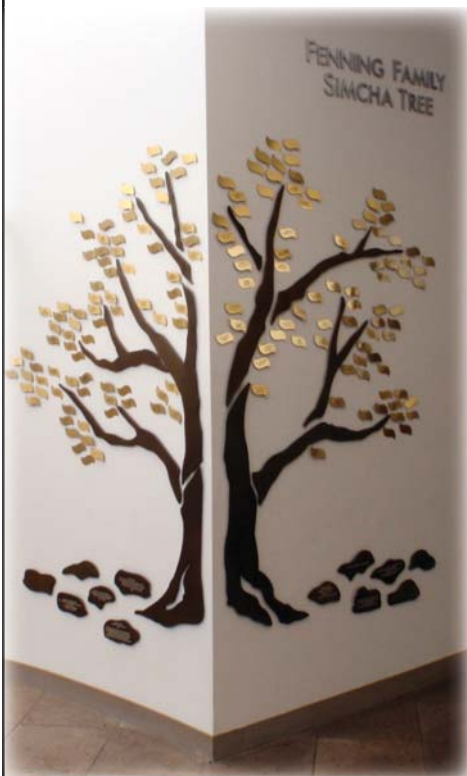

being led to the gas chambers singing ANI MA'AMIN, (I Believe), a song proclaiming their perfect faith in the coming of the Messiah in spite of the fact that he seems to tarry and be hopelessly late. It was an almost unbearable transformation of the horror of the moment through this musical affirmation. As they sang, those plaintive notes which sprung out of their parched and aching bodies must have ricocheted from the iron doors of the gas chambers straight to heaven's gates.

As an Israeli, I grew up with songs that described the years before, during and after The War of Independence, songs of lost sons, daughters, husbands, wives, brothers, sisters, friends, along with songs of pride, rebuilding, hope, gratitude and joy. The power of the music always outweighed the words. Ultimately, it seemed as if the words were not needed.

Here in the United States I remember being riveted by the power of thousands of voices joining in "We Shall Overcome". It seemed to be more hypnotic and galvanizing than the great speeches of the era which did deliver the message, but did not have the mesmerizing effect of the melodic crescendo rising on that "stairway to heaven" which defined the heart and soul of an entire generation.

Today, music seems to be everyone's domain, as indeed it should be. We identify decades and events by the songs of their particular period whether we are music "mavens" or not.

Personally, I will, as I do each year at this season, immerse my soul in Jewish music as well as ALL great music that transcends the years, the decades and even the centuries. For this is the music which is the most powerful reminder of music's divine origins.

In a world in which some days are seemingly lacking in God's presence, where frustration, struggles and challenges seem to be ever present, the loveliness created by random notes strung together into the magical beauty of melody, is all the evidence one would need that God is present. It is a loving gift that keeps on giving. Think of the baby who falls asleep to the sweet sounds of a lullaby, or the tunes of your youth when love was in the air. Remember the music of sad times and the melodies of the joyous moments. They are the "soul food" that nourishes ALL souls. Music ignites that divine spark that resides within, then envelopes it in a Godly embrace. Together they embody a most magical spiritual homecoming. Surely, this is as good as it gets...
